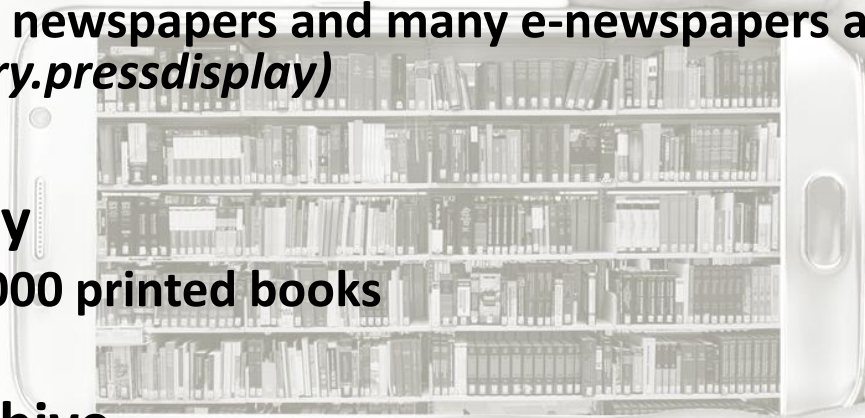

Library Access

- The library is open to all MPIA and HdA members around the clock.
- The services are for all MPIA and HdA members:
 - all MPIA and HdA staff and students
 - all technical and service departments, workers' council, administration etc.



1. New books or journals, exposed in the entrance room of the library for about a week must not be borrowed.
2. Borrowed books or journals must be indicated by replacing them with a legibly filled in shelf marker.
3. Borrowed books and journals are to be kept in plain view in the user's office and must not be taken out of the building or on a business trip.
4. Borrowed books or journals have to be returned to the library within **4 weeks**.
5. The person borrowing the book or journal remains responsible for returning it again. We strongly discourage handing over the book or journal without filling in a new shelf marker.

The **shelf marker** can be found in the library in sufficient numbers along with an explanation how to handle them.

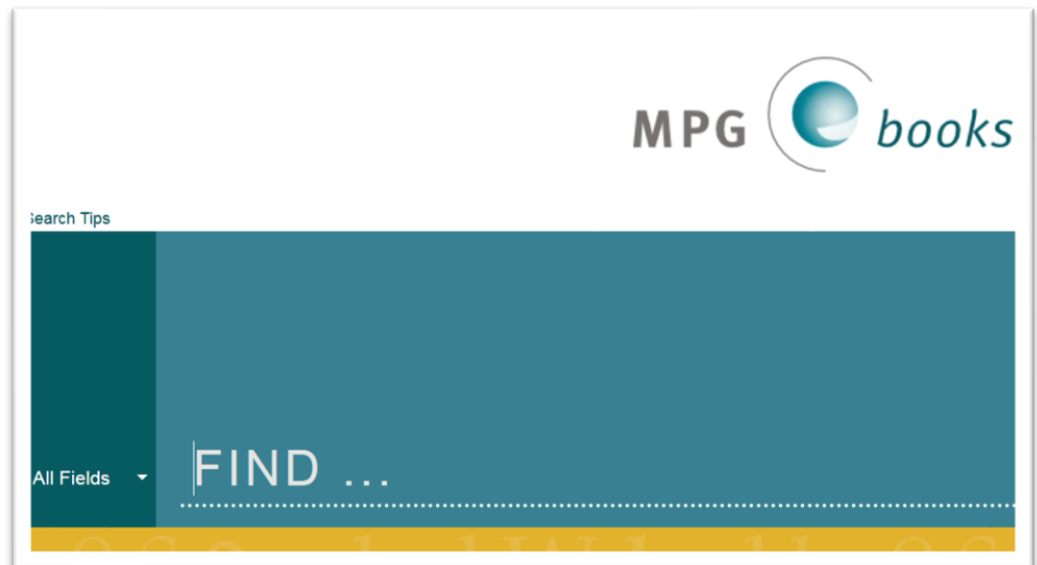
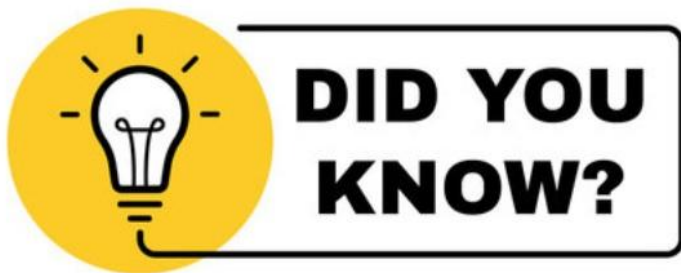


Finding Books
